About HBS

Hitchin Boys' School (HBS) has a history that stretches back nearly 400 years but embraces fresh thinking and a modern, vibrant curriculum. We have high expectations, excellent standards of behaviour and pride in our extra-curricular activities that lead to academically successful and well-rounded students who are well equipped for life beyond school.

In 2022 our results for both GCSE and A-level were as follows:

- 40% of GCSE results were a grade 7 or above.
- GCSE Progress 8 score of 0.43
- 91% of students achieved at least a grade 4 and 81% achieved grade 5
- An Average Points Score (Attainment 8) in PE of 5.91
- Across the wider school 88% of students achieved a grade 4 or higher in both English and Maths.
- At A level an Average Points Score of 36.36
- 100% pass rate (A* to E)
- 'An Outstanding School' Ofsted – 2021 and 2016
