Accommodation and facilities:

The Mathematics department is accommodated in a suite of 7 rooms, each having an interactive whiteboard (Smartboard). Staff will have access to the AQA Maths resources for GCSE and A Level as well as the White Rose resources for KS3. We also subscribe to a number of websites such as Mathsbox and goteachmaths.

What happens in the Mathematics Department?

- Students learn in a variety of ways, experiencing group and individual work as appropriate
- Students study the DSME curriculum in years 7 and 8 using the White Rose SOW and all students start the GCSE course in year 9.
- Students will sit GCSE Statistics in year 10.
- We use Sparx Maths for homework.
- We try to appeal to a variety of learning styles
- AIM students take part in the national UK Junior and Intermediate Challenges and also the Team Challenge run by Leeds University.
- Abbeyfield offers A level Maths and Further Maths as well as Core Maths in the sixth form.
- Student achievement is consistently high across all key stages and Mathematics is consistently one of Abbeyfield's strongest departments.
