MMUNITY SCHOOL

Testbourne Community School is in Whitchurch: a beautiful small, rural town in Hampshire surrounded by stunning countryside and famous locations such as the Silk Mill, Watership Down and the Bombay Sapphire distillery.

Our school has a 'small school' feeling despite there being over 900 students. Most students know several other children and many staff know students and their families. There is a genuine community ethos.

The students at Testbourne are able, articulate, well-behaved and friendly. They are a pleasure to teach and talk to; they can engage in mature conversation and debate. They help shape the direction of the school, namely through our established Prefect system and student council. Their conduct when representing the school or during internal events such as whole school Remembrance or our Festival of Sport is impeccable. Over 200 of our students volunteer to help on Open Evening. Many of our students participate in activities such as buddy reading, anti-bullying work,

eco work and a large number volunteer to help at school events. Older students look after the new arrivals and are very caring. When participating in external events, we always receive feedback from members of the public and organisers about how impeccably our students behaved.







Every student who attends Testbourne Community School is a member of a House, as well as our teaching and support staff. Each student will wear a Testbourne tie in their house colour to help indicate which house they belong to. Our four Houses are:









Testbourne Standards of Excellence:

- Kindness and respect We treat others, ourselves, and our environment with respect. We are kind and caring towards others. We never use prejudicial language or bully or harass people because of the gender, religion, ethnicity, race, sexuality, disability, or other protected characteristics. We value equality.

Achievement is also recognised by our Heads of Year through their weekly assemblies and certificates are awarded to deserving students at the end of every term. Our Headteacher also recognises significant achievements by writing personal letters to congratulate students and inviting them to afternoon tea. At the end of the academic year, we take pride in formally recognising our top performing students in our prestigious Prize Giving Ceremony at the Guildhall, Winchester.

At Testbourne we look after our staff from day one. We provide comprehensive induction which is highly valued by participants. Our decision making always considers the impact on staff workload. We are sympathetic to the need for flexibility in the workforce and would consider ourselves family friendly. We champion equality. We formally recognise hard work and excellence.

Our Leadership Team are highly visible leaders who are not afraid to 'roll their sleeves up' to assist students and staff. Each member of the team, including the headteacher, has break and lunch duty every day, takes a turn on bus duty, detention rotas and the on-call rota.

Staff at Testbourne have opportunities to develop their skills and their careers. We provide both external and in-house opportunities for staff to take on new

roles or gain further qualifications. We have opportunities to join the Leadership Team as Associate Assistant Headteachers; to take on additional responsibilities to developleadership skills; to receive internal promotions into roles more closely matching abilities; to complete the SENDCo training or NPQH/NPQSL. We also run internal courses to help future leaders develop their skills. We are highly rated for our teacher training provision and have strong links to the local teacher training providers.

Our CPD programmes, including full INSET days, are focussed on pedagogy and based around genuine research findings – not the latest fad, political distraction or buzz word. Staff are given information, time to discuss, reflect and develop. Staff are treated as professionals: respected, trusted and given autonomy alongside intelligent accountability. We have developed a philosophy of an Institute for Learning Excellence where everyone can develop, learn and grow as professionals.

We have supportive parents and an active parent association that raises considerable sums of money for the school.
