Specific responsibilities to the role:

The Second in Mathematics shall:

- Liaise with teachers in order to identify under achieving students and develop strategies to overcome this.
- Work alongside the Head of Maths and Deputy Headteacher to enhance the mathematics curriculum.
- Work alongside the Head of Maths and Deputy Headteacher to deliver numeracy across the curriculum.
- Act as a subject mentor for associate teachers and newly qualified teachers.
- To line manage subject staff with regard to specific subject schemes of work, assessment and promoting outstanding teaching and learning.
- To line manage and performance manage a number of staff in relation to set performance management guidelines as directed by the Head of Maths.
