MATHS

The department comprises five full-time and one part-time member of staff and is based in six classrooms, with all rooms benefiting from projectors, visualisers and interactive whiteboards. Maths is a popular subject in the school, and results have followed an upward trend in recent years. The department follows the AQA specification at GCSE (code 8300).

At Key Stage 3 and 4 we follow the Redhill Trust 5 year scheme of learning which is fluid and encourages the use of a wide and varied range of resources and teaching materials to help support pupil progress, as well as to enable enquiry-based learning. Teaching and assessment resources are also shared across the Trust to encourage collaboration between schools.

Using a Trust model allows for consistent assessments and interventions across Trust schools. This is facilitated by a Trust Director for Maths who works closely with all the schools.

Students have 3 hours of Maths lessons per week in years 7 and 8, and this increases to 4 hours per week and in years 9, 10 and 11. Those students requiring extra support take part in small-group intervention sessions or attend our increasingly popular maths clinic.

Maths forms a key component in any school and hence the successful candidate will play a crucial part in continuing to build on the successes of both the Maths department and the school as a whole.
