The Curriculum

KS3: Our students are organised into streams based on ability. We follow a bespoke 3 year scheme of work which has been adapted from the White Rose Maths Mastery course. This is designed to ensure that pupils have the key Mathematical knowledge to be successful at GCSE.

KS4: All students are entered for AQA Maths GCSE. Pupils are set based on ability, with half the cohort are entered into higher tier and the other half of the cohort entered into foundation.

KS5: We currently offer both EdExcel A Level in Mathematics and Further Mathematics.
