KS3

All students take a language of their choice (French, German or Spanish) at KS3, in addition to Latin. Students are taught in tutor groups at KS3.

KS4

Many students continue with a language to KS4, starting from Year 9. At this point students are placed into their option choice groups, which are typically smaller (approx 15-25 students per group).

KS5

We offer three languages at A level, with student numbers growing in recent years. There are a number of trips and enrichment activities offered during our Curriculum Challenge Week and Curriculum Enrichment Week.
