The Modern Foreign Languages Faculty at Hall Park Academy is a thriving faculty. We teach both Spanish and French from Year 7 through to Year 13. Spanish was introduced in 2024-25 for KS3 and we will continue to build the Spanish curriculum in the coming years.

At KS3, students learn French or Spanish, with the top two sets learning both. Students select their GCSE options at the end of Year 9 and recruitment to the Edexcel GCSE Spanish and French courses is strong.

We are proud to be part of the Redhill Academy Trust and benefit from working collaboratively with the other MFL departments within the Trust. Being part of the Trust also allows our team to engage in regular high-quality CPD.

The Modern Foreign Languages Faculty is committed to providing opportunities for students to visit foreign countries. We run an annual residential trip which alternates between Spain and France. We also have links with the University of Nottingham and engage with their MFL Widening Participation Programme as much as possible.
