# JOB DESCRIPTION – Teacher of Music (with some drama/performing arts)

Each member of staff at our school accepts responsibility for promoting and safeguarding the welfare of pupils in the school at all times.

#### **AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY AND KEY TASKS**

- Strategic Direction and Development of Music across the school (with the support of, and under the direction of, the Head of DT and the arts, and the SLT)
- Develop and implement policies and practices which reflect the school's commitment to high achievement through effective teaching and learning
- Have an enthusiasm for the subject which motivates and supports other staff and encourages a shared understanding of the contribution the curriculum can make to all aspects of pupils' lives
- Develop and update key documents for the department, such as curriculum maps, pathways and contribute to the arts development plan which are in line with the school development plan
- Contribute to the school's programme of extra-curricular activities, encouraging all pupils to participate, including the management of school performances and productions
- Lead trips relating to music and related areas of the curriculum

#### b) Teaching and Learning

- Display flair and creativity in engaging, enthusing and challenging groups of pupils
- Plan and teach well-structured lessons to assigned classes and demonstrate high quality teaching and learning where pupils are enthusiastic and respond positively to challenge and high expectations

- Assess, monitor, record and report on the learning needs, progress and achievements of assigned pupils, making accurate and productive use of assessment
- Adapt teaching to respond to the strengths and needs of pupils, ensuring that appropriate differentiation is used in lessons
- ensure continuity and progression in your curriculum area by setting clear learning objectives through an agreed scheme of work, developed in line with the school development plan
- Ensure good behaviour management of pupils, managing behaviour effectively to ensure a good and safe learning environment and encouraging pupils to display good behaviour for learning

# c) Effective Deployment of Resources

- Support the Headteacher and school business manager by maintaining efficient and effective management and organisation of learning resources, by developing or identifying new resources and providing excellent value for money
- Be aware of and respond appropriately to any health and safety issues raised by materials, practice or accommodation related to the subject

- Participate in the school's appraisal and performance management procedures
- Undertake necessary CPD to gain knowledge, understanding and skills appropriate to your role

#### e) General

- Be a form tutor for a tutor group (Years 6, 7 or 8) and contribute positively to the work of the year team
- Be a positive role model for pupils that reflects the professional attributes of an effective teacher
- Promote and maintain good communications with other staff, other school teams and external groups and agencies
- Actively work to promote safeguarding and support the DSL with safeguarding procedures
- Undertake any other duties as directed by the Headteacher
