## **Music Teacher**

### **Person Specification**

The following duties and responsibilities of all teaching members of the Music department are in addition to the standard scale job descriptions for all teachers at Camden School for Girls.

#### **The criteria for appointment will be:**

1. Excellent subject knowledge;
2. The ability to incorporate critical thinking skills into student learning;
3. Evidence of the requisite academic qualifications; a good Honours degree with a qualification to music at KS3, KS4 and KS5 levels.
4. An awareness of current issues in Equal Opportunities and in music education
5. Evidence of good oral and written communication skills;
6. Ability to work as a member of a team
7. Good personal skills.
8. Successful experience of teaching music in a secondary school. This could include teaching practice.
9. Evidence of further study or training (not NQTs)
10. Sympathy with the aims and ethos of the school

### **Curriculum**

- To teach classes within the department under the guidance of the Head of Department
- To teach lessons, organise resources and provide a stimulating environment for students
- To undertake, as appropriate, a share of curriculum planning and department organisation under the guidance of the Head of Department

### **Assessment**

- As a class teacher to mark work, assess students and write profiles in line with department and school policies
- As a tutor to monitor the overall progress of individual students
- To write and collate subject profiles
- To attend Parents' Evenings
- To identify students with particular learning needs and to discuss strategies for support with the Head of Department and Head of Year

### **General**

- To attend department, pastoral, staff and other meetings and play a part in the consultative systems of the school
- To carry out duties, e.g. break duty, in line with school policies
- To contribute to extra curricular activities
- To participate in the school's Appraisal Scheme
