POST OF FULL TIME PERMANENT TEACHER OF MUSIC

Thank you for your interest in the position of full time permanent teacher of music from 1 May 2022 or earlier if possible. The successful candidate will be teaching music at KS3 and KS4.

The Hollins serves an area of relative deprivation, with 62% of our students coming from E/E* areas of overall multiple deprivation and the prior attainment of our students is below average. However, examination results at KS4 show that attainment and achievement are good with the vast majority of our students making excellent progress.

The most recent Ofsted inspection (December 2017) recognised The Hollins as "a good school in all areas". Particular strengths were our SMSC provision and care, guidance and support of pupils, which were outstanding.

The Hollins has been granted an Academy Order to form a Multi-Academy Trust with another secondary school and two primary schools. We expect to convert on 1st March 2022 forming the LET Education Trust.
