JOB PURPOSE

To be responsible for the teaching and learning of all Music courses offered at Key Stages 3 and 4. This will involve the monitoring of students' progress and performance in order to ensure that expected learning outcomes are achieved. There will also be some teaching of Drama courses at Key Stages 3 and 4 as part of this role.

To participate in and make arrangements for Music to be prepared and featured in appropriate school assemblies and other after school functions, including productions.

Deputy Headteachers, Assistant Headteachers, Heads of Faculty, Heads of Year, Teaching Staff, Support Staff, parents and pupils.

Duties and Responsibilities

1. To teach throughout the full age range and ability within the college.
2. To assess and keep accurate records of students' progress within the agreed procedures of the faculty.
3. To identify students who are underperforming and put in place appropriate interventions to address this.
4. To set regular homework that supports learning taking place during lessons and promotes independence and responsibility.
5. To maintain an up-to-date knowledge and understanding of the requirements of the science curriculum.
6. To contribute to all aspects of work in the faculty, to ensure that the department is successful in teaching Music (and Drama) and continues to offer the pupils of the college a safe and stimulating environment.
7. To work as an important member of a team committed to teaching Music (and Drama), developing resources and courses and to assist the Head of Performing Arts to ensure the successful operation of the faculty.

8. To work collaboratively and cooperatively in a way which is conducive to maintaining the efficient management and organisation of the college, including undertaking weekly duties.
9. To assist in the delivery of Music (and Drama) qualifications and to have a secure knowledge and understanding of the subject, its requirements and related pedagogy.
10. To actively participate in and contribute to extra-curricular activities including within school and external events.
11. To engage in a process of continuing professional development in order to keep knowledge, skills and understanding updated in order to achieve the best possible impact in terms of learning outcomes.
12. Have an awareness of and implement Health & Safety legislative requirements and procedures in order to maintain a safe teaching environment where practical activities can take place.
