- To undertake assessment of students as requested by external examination bodies, departmental and school procedures.
- To mark, grade and give written/verbal and diagnostic feedback as required.
- To participate in and develop extra-curricular provision.
- To organise and run regular fixtures with other schools, as directed by the Head of Faculty.
