<b>2 Subject Knowledge</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Possessing an up-to-date understanding of teaching and learning in Physical Education, using innovative and engaging practice</li></ul>
<b>3 Lesson Planning</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Planning clearly and systematically in order to build on current and previous attainment of students</li></ul>
<b>4 Marking and Assessment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Marking books regularly and marking formal assessments promptly, in line with whole school expectations</li><li>▪ Monitoring progress in line with PE assessment policy in core PE</li></ul>
<b>5 Personal Development</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Willing to increase knowledge and skills, to reflect continually on practice and contribute to driving the department forwards with proven, research based strategies</li></ul>
