The Physical Education Department currently comprises five full time specialists, one part time specialist and one support assistant. There is a strong team ethos and a wide range of opportunities for students. We are looking for a Teacher of PE to join the department, who are focussed on delivering a higher level of success in terms of examination performance and team competitions.

The department's facilities include a sports hall, gym, 3G football pitch, multi-use games area (MUGA), fields allowing for a range of winter and summer activities and use of an on-site swimming pool.
