We are absolutely delighted to announce that Hinchley Wood School has been graded as 'Outstanding' in all areas reviewed during this comprehensive evaluation. The areas assessed include:

- Leadership and Management,
- Sixth Form Provision

This achievement is a testament to the unwavering dedication and hard work of our students and staff.

We are proud to remain an outstanding school. It is noteworthy that nationally, only 20% of schools that received an 'Outstanding' rating under the previous Ofsted criteria have maintained this top grading. In Surrey, this percentage drops even further, with only 8% of schools retaining their outstanding status. Our accomplishment, therefore, is truly exceptional and underscores the quality of education provided at Hinchley Wood School.

However, we recognise that the official report is subject to a strict word count, and there is so much more we would like to share with you. The full Ofsted Report is now available for you to read on our website. Here are a few highlights.

- Behaviour in and around school is of an exceedingly high quality.
- Pupils have extensive opportunities to take on leadership responsibilities.
- There is high ambition for all pupils, especially those who are disadvantaged.
- Relationships forged between staff and pupils are rooted in a genuine atmosphere of mutual respect. As a result, pupils enjoy their learning and relish being at school.
- Trustees and governors are clear and confident about their roles and responsibilities. They have a well-informed understanding of the school. Leaders are fully held to account for the school's performance.
 - Attendance is high, including in the sixth form, because pupils want to come to school.

- The school is responsive to pupils' views and interests, developing their character and leadership skills.
- The curriculum extends beyond the academic and actively fosters pupils' personal development. Leaders have ensured that all pupils have access to a wide-ranging and rich set of experiences.
- Pupils say bullying is extremely rare and dealt with well by the school.
 Pupils feel safe and happy in the school.
 - The arrangements for safeguarding are effective.
- Pupils with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND) thrive, because their needs are identified and catered for precisely. This includes pupils supported by the NAS Cullum Centre.
 - Ongoing curriculum improvement is a strong feature of the school.
