Staffing

Psychology is currently delivered as part of the Humanities suite of A levels. The Humanities faculty at The Hall Park Academy consists of nine members of staff including a Head of Faculty. The team are hard-working, have high levels of personal responsibility and are strongly supportive of each other. Friendly but professional working relationships exist between all staff, both teaching and non-teaching.

Accommodation

This consists of nine classrooms, all within the same block. Psychology is taught in a large flexible classroom.

Curriculum

Psychology students follow the AQA A-level Psychology specification. All aspects of the course are delivered by one teacher. Currently, the optional units studied are Stress, Relationships and Aggression.
