Psychology

Psychology is a growing subject at KS5 with increasing numbers of students selecting the course each year.

We currently have three groups of students in Year 12 and three in Year 13, who have all opted for Psychology A Level. The groups are shared between two members of the department. We follow the AQA specification with lessons designed to ensure students are able to:

- explore the main theories
- conducting research
- critique psychological research and theory
- complete independent wider reading of psychological articles
- evaluate key psychological concepts, synoptic links, issues and debate
