Psychology is offered at KS4 and KS5 at the Redhill Academy and is a very popular choice for students here.

OCR specification is followed for KS4 and AQA is followed for the A level course. For our KS5 Paper 3 options we deliver Relationships, Forensic Psychology and Eating Behaviour. We have one class in both years 10 and 11 and three classes in both year 12 and 13, making us one of the largest subject cohorts.

The courses are delivered using a wide variety of teaching strategies in an active classroom. Psychology results are consistently high and we strive to increase maximum achievement at every opportunity.

SOCIOLOGY

Sociology is an important and growing part of the curriculum across the Trust in Key Stage 5.

A Level Sociology was introduced eight years ago and is now one of the most popular subjects at KS5. The numbers are continuously growing which is reflected in the strong numbers. There are currently two groups in Year 12 and two groups in Year 13 totaling over 70 students across the two year groups.

The AQA specification is delivered at the Academy with students studying Culture and Identity, Education and Research Methods in Year 12, and Crime and Deviance, The Media and Theory and Methods in Year 13.

The A Level Sociology results are consistently outstanding and overall student engagement with the subject is high.
