Subject leaders have a thoughtful approach to the curriculum, prioritising the needs of the pupils. They place a great deal of trust in the teachers, who are knowledgeable.' Inspectors also reported that "there are clear and high expectations for behaviour that pupils know and understand. Staff apply the behaviour policy consistently".
