

SCIENCE

The Science department comprises eight teachers and two technicians. It is situated in purose-built laboratories, with all rooms benefiting from projectors, visualisers and interactive whiteboards. Science is a popular subject in the school, and results have followed an upward trend in recent years, becoming one of the strongest performing subjects in school. The department follows the AQA Combined Science Trilogy and Separate Science specifications at GCSE.

The department works under the leadership of the Head of Faculty, and due to a vacancy becoming available, we are now seeking to appoint a Second in Science. Common schemes of learning, resources and assessments are in place, and the department works closely with the Director of Science for the Redhill Trust.

Students study a broad and balance curriculum in Year 7, 8 and 9. Students have 3 science lessons per week in KS3. The GCSE courses starts in Year 10. Students receiver 5 hours of Science lessons per week in Combined Science, and an additional 4 hours for Separate Sciences.
