We are seeking to appoint an enthusiastic biology/chemistry/physics/science teacher to join our experienced faculty of Science staff. The successful applicant will be required to teach at all levels of the biology/ chemistry/physics/ science curriculum throughout the secondary phases, although their deployment will be dependent upon their strengths and experience.

It is important that the successful candidate is a good fit in our team, and so they may be highly experienced or just starting out on their teaching journey, what matters to us is their passion for teaching, strength as a classroom practitioner and love of their subject area. **NQTs who can demonstrate the potential to be outstanding teachers are encouraged to apply.**

The College encourages applications from those of the Catholic faith, but it is not a barrier to appointment if candidates do not have that faith background provided they support the ethos of the College. We are extremely proud of our ethos which comes in very large part from our Jesuit Associate School membership and Catholic Diocesan heritage.
