## About the Science Department

The Science Department is committed to igniting students' natural curiosity about the world around them and helping them explore the phenomena that shape their everyday lives. Through a rich and engaging curriculum, students are encouraged to question, investigate, and develop scientific explanations that deepen their understanding of how our world works.

### Curriculum Pathways

#### Key Stage 3

In Years 7, 8 and 9, students follow the National Curriculum for Science. Each class is taught by a single teacher, enabling strong relationships and continuity across Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

#### Key Stage 4

Students follow the AQA Trilogy or AQA Separate Sciences pathways. Trilogy Science provides a balanced and comprehensive foundation across all three disciplines. Separate Sciences are offered to around 60 students annually, enabling an in-depth study of Biology, Chemistry and Physics over two years. A small number of students complete a Single Award in Biology as part of a personalised curriculum. During Key Stage 4, lessons are delivered by specialist teachers. Outcomes are consistently strong.

#### Key Stage 5

Biology, Chemistry and Physics are all offered at A Level and remain among the most popular subjects in the Sixth Form. Across Years 12 and 13, eleven Science classes run each year. Students achieve excellent results and many progress to study science-related degrees at some of the UK's most prestigious universities. Several students secure Nuffield Scientific Research Placements, and many use scientific issues as the focus of their Extended Project Qualifications, further developing their research and analytical skills.

### Beyond the Classroom

The Science curriculum is enriched by an impressive programme of extra-curricular and enrichment opportunities. These experiences broaden students' understanding of science in real-world contexts and nurture the next generation of scientific thinkers.

### Facilities and Staff

The department is the largest in the school, staffed by eleven highly experienced, specialist teachers, supported by two laboratory technicians. Teaching takes place in eight fully equipped laboratories, each fitted with interactive technology to enhance learning.

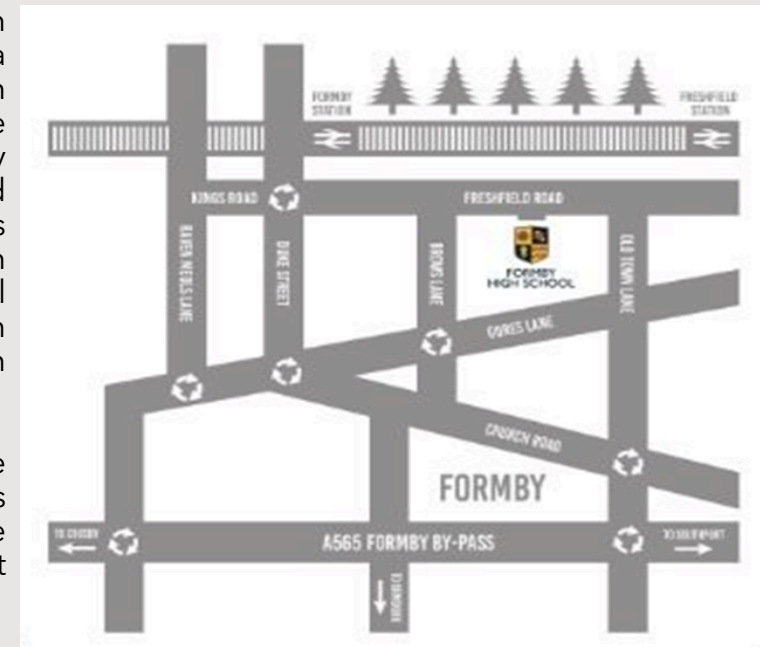
## Safeguarding Statement

Formby High School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of young people. The successful applicant will be required to undertake an Enhanced DBS check, and personal information will be cross-referenced in line with our Safeguarding Policy. We also carry out online checks on shortlisted candidates in accordance with our Safer Recruitment Policy.



The school is situated in leafy Freshfield, situated in the north of Formby. Trains run every fifteen minutes between Liverpool and Southport on Merseyrail's Northern Line and the school is a short walk from Formby and Freshfield stations. The school is easily accessible by car with Formby being serviced by good roads links from the north and south. There is also an extensive network of cycle routes in the local area which allow for generally 'hills-free' cycling! Formby has a population of circa 30,000 and is located 12 miles north of Liverpool, a vibrant and progressive city with distinct character. The Sefton coastline is beautiful and Formby benefits from the National Trust nature reserve, home to its famous red squirrels. Just to the south Anthony Gormley's Iron Men can be found on Crosby beach. Formby has excellent local amenities and the school is only a short walk from the village centre. Although generally an affluent area, house prices are varied and recently there has been considerable investment in new housing.

The school buildings are set in 30 acres of grounds. There is plenty of green space and the campus is lined with mature trees. The original building was erected in time for the school's opening in 1938 and further buildings were erected as the school population grew during the 1970s. A purpose built Sixth Form Centre was opened on site in 2004 and a new SEN unit building is due to open in Autumn 2024.



Due to the popularity of the school, most students live in very close proximity and walk or cycle to school with only a small number travelling from the north or south by train. As the school's admissions criteria gives high priority to siblings, families develop a long-standing relationship with the school as all of their children pass through.
