Job Purpose:

1. To maintain professional standards as set out in the DfE's Teachers' Standards
2. To ensure students are engaged and making good progress according to their age, interests and abilities

5. To support the Science curriculum area in maintaining a positive learning environment and effective, cooperative working relationships between staff, students and parents

Key Tasks (as a Teacher of Science):

1. To teach Science at Key Stages 3, 4 and 5 (depending on experience and specialism)
2. To contribute to the delivery of the Science curriculum and to the curriculum area development plan
3. To collaborate with colleagues on the development of resources for the delivery of the curriculum

Key Tasks (as classroom teacher):

1. To plan, deliver and review lessons which are appropriate to the age and ability of students and in accordance with the National Curriculum / awarding body specifications so as to facilitate progression in learning
2. To maintain high standards of teaching and learning that ensure the progress of all students, including those from disadvantaged backgrounds and with SEND
3. To plan, set and assess appropriate work, and to record results in accordance with the school's Assessment, Recording and Reporting Policy so as to provide regular feedback and monitoring of progress
4. To participate in the school's procedures for monitoring the quality of teaching
5. To engage in relevant CPD in order to develop and enhance professional practice
6. To manage the classroom and associated equipment so as to create a positive learning environment, making effective use of available resources
7. To arrange for the provision of suitable work for classes in the event of absence
8. To contribute to the delivery of the School Improvement and Development Plan

Key Tasks (as form tutor):

1. To act as form tutor and implement the RESPECT (Resilience, E-Safety, Social, Personal, Economic and Citizenship Teaching) curriculum
2. To liaise with the Climate for Learning Leader as part of a pastoral team to maintain a caring, well-ordered and effective school learning environment
