School Curriculum

At North, we have designed a curriculum that is ambitious and gives all learners the knowledge and cultural capital they need to be confident citizens and succeed in life. It is planned and sequenced towards cumulatively securing detailed knowledge and skills for future learning and employment.

In Year 9, all students study a Core Key Stage 3 Curriculum. This consists of English, Maths, Science, History, Geography, RE, Computer Science, PE and either French or Spanish. We also offer an experience of other subjects, in preparation for GCSE choices. These are on a rotation of 18 lessons per subject in groups of three: art, media and music; iMedia, health; business studies and Textiles, Food and Design Technology. The curriculum also enables students to develop their character through the CARE (PHSE) lessons which allows their resilience, confidence and independence to thrive.

Our rich and ambitious academic curriculum embodies our school's motto 'Studies Determine Character'. It offers every student, whatever their ability, the opportunity to

excel academically and also places a clear value on the arts and creative subjects (art, photography, music, drama, dance, design technology, engineering, food).

At North, every child and every grade is important.

We place equal emphasis and celebrate the success of a student who has been targeted and achieves their nine grade 9s, in the same way as the student who meets and succeeds at lower target grades. We take the time to design our curriculum which is centred on the student and ensure that we support them at every stage of the options process in Year 9 selecting the correct courses, allowing them to go on to be successful citizens and make a positive contribution to society.

The GCSEs provide a seamless transition to courses on offer at our popular Sixth Form; this time offers an exciting chapter in our students' academic journey and we look forward to working with our new cohort and celebrating their forthcoming success and achievements.

CPD at North

We provide a full range of CPD opportunities to support all staff to continually deliver the best in all they do.

Our Teaching & Learning CPD includes:

- In Service Training (INSET) which is delivered during non-teaching days and a variety of twilight sessions.
- Attendance at external training events.

There are also Progress Leaders, department meetings, pastoral meetings, regular teaching and non-teaching staff meetings - all allowing opportunities to communicate, share good practice and ensure everyone is secure in the part they play in the success of the school.

We actively work with other schools to share good practice and challenge each other as we develop and adapt to ongoing educational changes.

In order to support current and aspirant leaders, we encourage participation in local and national leadership training programmes.

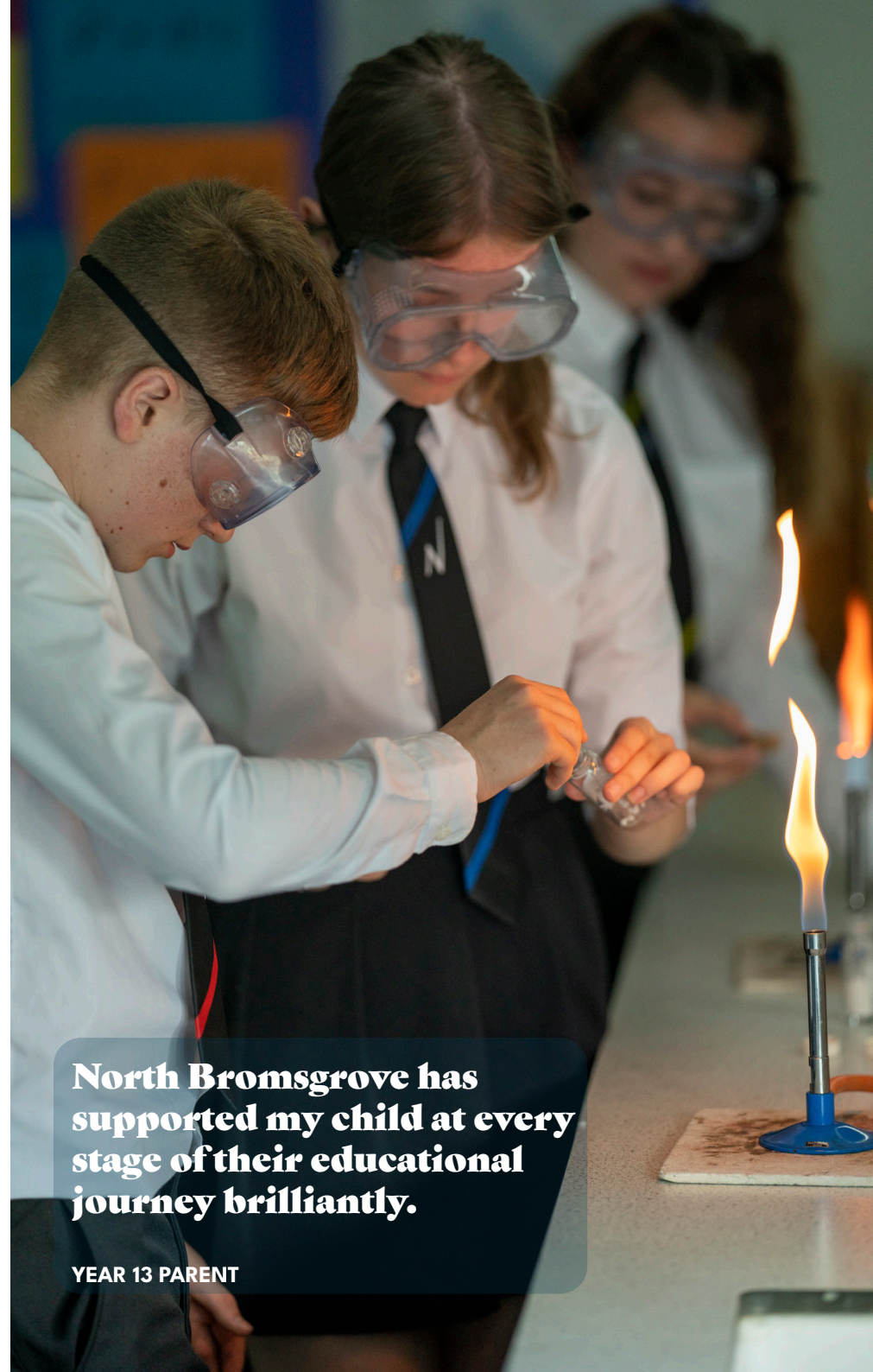
Do you relish the chance to support colleagues to make rapid sustained school improvement? If so, we have the perfect opportunity for you!
