



EVIDENCE OF YOUR RIGHT TO WORK IN THE UNITED KINGDOM

If your application is successful it will be necessary, under statutory provision, for you to provide evidence of your right to work in the United Kingdom.

This can be provided by documentary evidence of your National Insurance Number. Such documentation can be a P45, a pay-slip, a P60, National Insurance card or via a letter issued by one of the Government bodies concerned

If you do not have a National Insurance number please contact the school for further advice as soon as possible.

Please note that the evidence of your right to work must be provided before a letter of appointment can be issued.
