JOB PURPOSE

To be responsible for the teaching and learning of all Spanish courses offered at Key Stages 3 and 4. This will involve the monitoring of students' progress and performance in order to ensure that expected learning outcomes are achieved.

Duties and Responsibilities

1. To teach throughout the age and ability range as detailed in the National Curriculum and examination board requirements.
2. To assess and record pupils' progress within the guidelines of National Curriculum and the agreed procedures of the faculty.
3. To maintain an up-to-date knowledge and understanding of the requirements of the Spanish curriculum.
4. To contribute to all aspects of work in the faculty, to ensure that the department is successful in teaching Spanish and continues to offer the pupils of the college a safe and stimulating environment.
5. To work as an important member of a team committed to teaching Spanish, developing resources and courses and to assist the Director of Languages to ensure the successful operation of the faculty.
6. To work collaboratively and cooperatively that is conducive to maintaining the efficient management and organisation of the College, which includes weekly duties.
7. To assist in the delivery of Spanish qualifications and to have a secure knowledge and understanding of the subject, its requirements and related pedagogy.
8. To engage in a process of continuing professional development in order to keep knowledge, skills and understanding updated in order to achieve the best possible impact in terms of learning outcomes.
9. Have an awareness of and implement Health & Safety legislative requirements and procedures in order to maintain a safe teaching environment where practical activities can take place.
