- Be proactive in fully filling all aspects of the job criteria to at least expected standards.

- Have written and oral skills of a high order.
- Display a clear sense of vision of the role.
- Be able to build professional relationships and work sensitively with a wide variety of people.
- Demonstrate good presentational skills.

- Have a love for teaching and learning and sensitivity to young people
- Have integrity, optimism, flexibility, resilience
- Have stamina to cope with the demands of the post
- Be able to adapt to changing circumstances and new ideas
- Show commitment, reliability and integrity
