Our history

Ebor Academy Trust was established in 2013 when a school that was consistently underperforming requested help from Robert Wilkinson Primary School in Strensall, York. Together, these two schools established our trust and in January 2017 the previously struggling school received its first positive inspection report in 17 years when it went from Special Measures to Good.

We continue to collect evidence, via Ofsted reports, parents and carers and from among our peers, that the systems and the approaches we adopt make a positive difference to the educational landscape across the four local authority areas in which we operate – York, North Yorkshire, the East Riding of Yorkshire and Hull.

Ebor comprises 22 primary schools and one special school, serving over 5,000 children and young people from the ages of two to 11.
