The candidate must be able to demonstrate the ability and willingness to work with children of all abilities and needs, including those pupils with medical needs.

We shall look for evidence of excellent working relationships with children, staff, parents and governors. The ability to work collaboratively and be flexible is expected. Previous examples of successful teamwork will be discussed.

Desirable knowledge and skills

- A candidate willing to be trained in and lead out medical procedures.
- For the part-time role, expertise in the Early Years Foundation Stage.
- For the full-time role, experience in Key Stage 2.
- A person who is prepared to be involved in the community life of the school e.g. PTA events.
- Specific areas of specialism that could contribute to the wider life of the school, e.g. music, sport, arts, languages.
- Higher Level Teaching Assistant Status.
