Support for the Teacher • Assist with planning and organising resources. • Prepare the classroom environment. • Provide feedback on progress and behaviour. • Support IEPs, behaviour plans and assessments. • Liaise with teachers, SENDCo and external professionals. Support for Pupils • Build positive relationships and act as a role model. • Support emotional regulation and independence. • Promote inclusion and equitable access. Additional Needs • Provide SEND, EAL and pastoral support. • Adapt activities for full participation. • Assist with personal care respectfully. • Support SEN plans and reviews.
Support During Transitions	• Support routines, lesson movement, activity transitions and home-time. • Provide reassurance for pupils who struggle with change. • Maintain calm and safe movement around school.
Playtime and Lunchtime Duties	• Supervise pupils on the playground and at lunch. • Promote positive play and safe behaviour. • Support children needing extra help. • Promote social skills and solve minor conflicts. • help ensure safety and welfare across the school site.
Whole School Responsibilities	• Uphold Holy Trinity's values and ethos. • Contribute to a caring and aspirational environment. • Build professional relationships with parents.
