Qualifications, skills and experience

Some experience of supporting children in a similar setting is desirable but not essential.

Deployment

The successful candidate will be deployed in a class to support the learning of pupils as directed by the classteacher. Some experience of teaching in a similar setting is desirable but not essential. Full-training will be provided by the school and the successful candidate will have regular in-house training on different aspects of teaching and learning.
