Our students will leave Haileybury Turnford knowing they have achieved their personal best and with qualifications that will ensure they progress confidently to college, university and employment.

Our sponsor is Haileybury, the leading independent boarding school, seven miles north of our school. We are an Equal Opportunities employer. ### **Examples of our partnership with Haileybury**

- Our Cadets have weekly training with Haileybury Cadets.
- Our Year 11 Maths and Spanish students have had regular sessions with Haileybury staff to provide additional specialist teaching to support them.
- Our Year 11 and Year 12 Science students have had regular additional workshops at Haileybury.
- Haileybury provides support for Year 13 students applying for medicine, dentistry and veterinary science. Haileybury also support students with their applications to other competitive university courses, including preparation for interviews at Cambridge and Oxford universities.
- Students use Haileybury's sports facilities including the climbing wall and swimming pool.
- Year 7 and Year 8 students at Haileybury Turnford and Haileybury work and learn together in a series of regular masterclasses across the academic year.

# Exam Results - Big improvements at HT

In 2019 we saw significant improvements in our GCSE, vocational and A Level exam results.

Over the past two years we have seen a 15% A\*-B increase in A Level grades. Our Progress Score for A Level Performance in 2019 was the highest progress score amongst local 16-18 state school provision and ranked us 26<sup>th</sup> out of 125 Hertfordshire 16-18 providers and 16<sup>th</sup> for academies and maintained schools. Our vocational results have

continued their stellar performances with outcomes and progress remaining high. We continue to have real student success across the range of vocational subjects offered with many top grades achieved in Business, ICT, Health & Social Care and Drama. We are delighted that we have had three students achieving places at Cambridge and Oxford Universities in the past two years studying Human, Social and Political Sciences, English and Physics.

At GCSE, our students had great success in 2019 across a wide range of subjects including in English, Maths, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Business, Dance, Engineering, Geography and Photography. Our Progress 8 score for all Year 11 students was -0.14. 53% of our students achieved both at least a grade 4 in Maths and English, with significantly higher outcomes in both Maths and English individually. Our Progress score for Maths was +0.39, showing exceptional progress for our students of all abilities. It placed us 12<sup>th</sup> for progress in Maths in Hertfordshire.

We are confident that our exam results will continue to show further improvements in progress and attainment for GCSE, vocational and A Level students from 2021, following the award of centre-assessed grades in summer 2020.

# **Staff Wellbeing and Benefits**

The school offers all its staff a range of benefits including:

#### **Recruitment Incentives**

We will consider giving financial recruitment and retention incentives to outstanding candidates. In addition, the school will pay back training fees up to a maximum of £8,000 over 4 years for Newly Qualified Teachers who join us.

#### **Professional Development Opportunities**

We offer excellent induction and training to support professional development to all teaching and support staff. We have programmes in place for Newly Qualified Teachers as well as aspiring Middle Leaders and Senior Leaders. There are also opportunities to work with teaching and support staff at our sponsor, Haileybury. Support staff are also well catered for with specific training to support individual roles. There are also additional coaching and research opportunities available to help support our teaching and learning culture in the school. We work with a range of different teacher training providers which gives mentoring opportunities to a number of our staff.

# Wellbeing

Free flu jabs and other wellbeing support, advice, confidential information and counselling is provided through Education Mutual. We also have a regular staff yoga session for interested staff, and a complimentary therapist visits weekly to offer Indian head massage and reflexology. In addition, our Staff Room was recently fully reburbished. There are also regular Staff Forum & Wellbeing Meetings, Staff Coffee Mornings and a staff BAME Forum focused on ensuring we have the best possible working environment for all staff.

### **Shared Ownership Scheme**

Working with B3 Living, we are able to offer a flexible and affordable scheme to support buying your own home. We are the only local school to provide this opportunity for teaching staff with permanent contracts.
