Temporary Cover Supervisor

Saint John Wall Catholic School is an oversubscribed 11-16 school with a diverse population, serving the community of North West Birmingham. Over 50% of our pupils qualify for additional Pupil Premium funding, and over 60% of our pupils speak English as an Additional Language.

The school's Progress 8 score is well above national. In June 2023, Ofsted judged the school Good with outstanding behaviour and attitudes and outstanding leadership and management. Ofsted reported that 'Pupils blossom in this unique and caring school. Everyone is welcome and staff and pupils care for and look out for each other. Classrooms are places where teachers teach, and pupils learn.'

The Role

- As a Cover Supervisor you will communicate, distribute and supervise work that has been set by the teacher, in accordance with school policy.
- You will manage the behaviour of the pupils, whilst they are undertaking the work, to ensure a constructive environment and report back to the teacher.
- You will respond to questions from pupils about process and procedures, but excluding lesson content.
- You will be required to deal with any immediate problems or emergencies according to the school's policies and procedures.
- You will collect the completed work at the end of the lesson and return it to the appropriate teacher.
- When not providing cover, you will support the Office Manager with admin based tasks in the School Office to ensure the smooth running of the school.

The Individual

You are someone who has strong academic skills, and who can work sensitively with pupils from a wide range of diverse backgrounds and religions. We are a 'Catholic School For All', and that will be at the heart of everything you do. You will need to be flexible in the role according to the needs of the school and pupil needs.
