Purpose

Duties and Responsibilities

- Live our mission, values and drivers every day.
- Work collaboratively with teachers and leaders across all of our trust's academies to share best practice, develop resources, and support consistent high standards in teaching and learning for Year 10 and Year 11.
- Lead targeted interventions and support strategies to raise attainment in Year 10 and Year 11, using data to identify priorities and measure impact across the trust.
- Champion the use of technology to enhance teaching and learning, including the development and delivery of remote, blended, or digital-first lessons to reach the greatest number of students.
- Design and deliver professional development sessions for colleagues across the trust, focusing on evidence-based instructional strategies and innovative use of technology.
- Contribute to trust-wide curriculum development, assessment design, and quality assurance processes to ensure consistency and excellence in provision for Year 10 and Year 11.
- Report on progress and impact to trust leaders, providing data and case studies to inform trust strategy and improvement planning.
- In accordance with schemes of work, plan, deliver and review lessons which are appropriate to the age and ability of the students, so as to facilitate progression in students' learning.
- Ensure that teaching is broad, balanced, relevant, motivational and appropriately differentiated in order to maximise the academic potential of all students.
- Facilitate the exceptional progress and wellbeing of any individual or group of students, target individual students' needs in lessons.
- Promote and maintain discipline in accordance with the rules and behaviour policy of the academy.
- Ensure effective use of formative and summative assessment to drive planning and interventions.
- Provide feedback that moves learning forward.
- Manage the classroom and teaching equipment to create a positive learning environment which makes effective use of available resources.
- Ensure that homework is set, where appropriate, and monitored.
- Support students throughout the day by fulfilling pastoral responsibilities.
- Engage fully in our trust's professional growth process to fulfil personal potential and be able to participate effectively in the implementation of our trust's strategic big moves.
- Attend meetings / training and carry out administrative tasks and duties as specified on our trust calendar.
- Consistently implement all trust policies and contribute to decision-making and consultation procedures.
- Report any safeguarding concerns immediately to a designated safeguarding lead.
- Carry out any other reasonable duties as requested by the principal / trust leader.
