Khalsa Primary School

Khalsa Primary School unique primary school: it is the founding school of Sikh Academies Trust, and it was judged 'Outstanding' in in its recent Ofsted inspection in September 2023. The school is housed in a spacious and purpose-built building with exceptional resources. There is a Gurdwara on site.

Khalsa Primary School is a 2 form-entry school with nearly 500 pupils. Our results to date for Early Years, Phonics, KS1 and KS2 are significantly above the national averages. Places at Khalsa Primary School are in demand and community confidence in the school is very high.

Leaders have an unwavering vision that all pupils will achieve highly and become exemplary citizens. Leaders' belief that 'better never stops' has driven them to create an inspirational curriculum from Nursery to Year 6. In every subject, the key knowledge, skills and vocabulary that pupils must understand and learn are structured in a logical order. Teachers know precisely what pupils must learn. In the Nursery and Reception Years, teachers skilfully weave children's interests through the curriculum. Pupils in all year groups delight in their learning and are exceptionally well prepared for what comes next.
