Supervisory Responsibility: Supervision of non-teaching assistant/support assistants/students and other persons available to assist in the classroom.

Supervision and Guidance: Supervision and guidance will be received from the Headteacher, other members of the Leadership team, from subject co-ordinators with specific curriculum responsibilities, and from external agencies, eg Local Authority officers, Educational Psychological Service etc.

Range of Decision Making and Responsibilities:

Responsibility for teaching a class within the 4 - 11 age range and specifically for children aged 9-11 years in the first instance.

Responsibility for Assets:

- 1. Resources in your classroom and within your curriculum area
- 2. Pupil records and assessments
