Acorn Education Trust was established in 2014 to provide a local solution to a national strategy. Our mission: to "prepare young people for their world in their time" through excellent leadership, excellent teaching and excellent learning is at the heart of all that we do. Kingdown School is the founding school alongside Dilton Marsh Church of England Primary School and The Avenue Primary School. Acorn now serves 17 schools (3 secondary and 14 primary).

One of the Trust's main operational objectives is to ensure the Headteacher focuses on leading teaching and learning, so the business element is mainly managed by Trust staff. Reducing back office staff by sharing resources, improving IT and school to school support is keeping each school financially healthy and directing as much money as possible into teaching and learning. As mentioned in the acrostic above, professional development is a key priority and we hope that whoever joins a school in the Trust will see the potential career opportunities within Acorn.

While Directors are very keen for all schools to develop their unique identity and serve their community, there are key areas where the Trust expects to see standardisation or alignment. Within the primary school context this relates to: assessment; health and safety and various policies.

The Directors maintain overall responsibility for all Trust schools, however they delegate many tasks to each school Academy Council of Governors through the scheme of delegation. The Academy Council at Wansdyke School works collaboratively with the Senior Leadership Team to ensure high challenge and support.

The School

Wansdyke School is a vibrant primary school which is committed to continually raising standards and achieving excellence through providing exciting and memorable learning opportunities for every child. In our most recent inspection, we were graded as good. We have fantastic children and an engaged school community. Located on the outskirts of the delightful market town of Devizes, Wansdyke School is a thriving academy, within the Acorn Education Trust. Situated in the heart of beautiful, rural Wiltshire, Devizes has excellent access to routes to Chippenham, Swindon and the M4 to the north, and the A303/M3 to the south.

Wansdyke School is a single form entry school with a 28 place Complex Needs Resource Base, so we have 234 pupils on roll. We have no mixed aged classes and our maximum class size is 30 pupils. The resource base brings an atmosphere of inclusion and tolerance and we are very proud it is a part of our school.





At Wansdyke we aim to encourage all our children to achieve their fullest potential, not only in what they learn in the classroom, but across the whole spectrum of school life. We aspire to enable all children at Wansdyke to make outstanding progress and leave the school at least reaching the national expectation in Reading, Writing and Maths. In the Complex Needs Resource Base we provide a personalised curriculum based on each child's individual profile.
